Dear Parents,

As a primary spiritual trainer for your child, you will play a very special part in their Confirmation instruction. There are several ways I hope to involve you this year:

- ✓ **PRAYER**—I know this should go without saying, but pray for your child each day. Ask God to bless them with wisdom, courage, and spiritual growth. Also, *tell* your child that you are praying for them and what you are asking of God. You will also be expected to meet daily with your child using “The Home Huddle Journal” from their “Head to the Heart” (H2H) books. This will be a time of prayer, scripture and sharing each day and will help reinforce what is taught Wednesday night as well as create or enhance a family devotion time in your home.
- ✓ **MEMORY WORK**— Help your child with their memory work assignments at home. This requires that you sit down with your child and not only help them learn their memory assignments, but watch them write it out, grading their work once completed.
- ✓ **SERMON NOTES**—Go through each Sermon Study with your child *that Sunday afternoon or evening sometime*. Have them complete the form on their own, then talk through it with them. Share your own personal insights. Use the sermon outline as a guide or help.

COSTS:

- ◆ **\$20.00**/student—small group study materials for the year—**ALL** students.
- ◆ **\$10.00**/student—catechism—for **6th grade students, new students or any student lacking one**. If the student already has a catechism, they need not purchase a new one.

THE “BASIC TRAINING” PROGRAM

- ◆ Our Savior's confirmation program is called BASIC TRAINING. The name carries with it two major implications.
 - (1) We will be providing a foundational, or BASIC education in the teachings of the Lutheran Church.
 - (2) This is only the first of many TRAINING steps the confirmands will have in an ever-deepening relationship with Jesus Christ.
- ◆ Confirmation (BASIC TRAINING) will occur on Wednesday evenings for all students desiring to become confirmed members of Our Savior congregation.
- ◆ Our small group format will be gender-specific groups of 6-8 students. The goal is to promote more meaningful discussions and corporate prayer, while dismantling clique affiliation.
- ◆ Basic Training begins at 6:30 PM. Please make sure that your child arrives **BEFORE** that time so as to avoid missing any important information, and to keep other students from being interrupted by their late arrival.
- ◆ We can't do it **for** you, but we'd love to do it **with** you! We want to assist your family in the faith development of your child, but we can't do it without your help. Below are some thoughts to keep in mind:
 - (1) Faith in God is a lifelong commitment so encourage your child by showing them the importance of attending all BASIC TRAINING events. If you child doesn't attend the events we offer (retreats, servant opportunities, etc.), they will get less out of the program, have a greater difficulty making new friends and will be more likely be inactive or drop out of the youth program when entering High School.
 - (2) Worship together each Sunday. I know that it goes without saying, but your child looks to the parent for the example and if they don't see you involved they won't see a need to be involved either. This can eventually lead to them growing less interested in worship and serving Christ in His Church.
 - (3) Participate in the spiritual growth opportunities offered each Sunday. Again, this seems obvious, but if you do not attend a Sunday morning Bible class, it will seem rather hypocritical to make them attend the junior youth bible studies (**which is a BASIC TRAINING requirement**).
 - (4) Talk to your child about their faith—and your own! A great time to do this will be during your Home Huddle time. Talking about your faith (as well as their own faith) will not only show your child that you are interested in their spiritual growth, but will likely help them maintain a higher level of interest in their own spiritual growth.

MAKE SURE THEY COME PREPARED!

Each Wednesday evening, each student should bring to Basic Training:

- their Bible
- their “Head to the Heart” Yearbook and Home Journal
- A spiral bound notebook
- their “Home Huddle Journal” completed for the past week
- their catechisms

Things that SHOULD NOT come to class:

- ◆ MP3, CD or other music players are not allowed in class. *If these electronic devices are found they will be confiscated and returned at the end of class. If there is a second offense they will be taken until a parent can pick them up. In the case of a third offense, they become a great new toy for Pastor or Shawn.*
- ◆ Cell phones should be turned to “vibrate” mode (or turned off) during class. They may not be used in any way except to receive a call in an emergency.
- ◆ No food or drink will be allowed in or during class. All food and drink must be finished before class begins.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

6th –8th GRADE

◆ **Attendance at Wednesday Confirmation Class (6:30—8:00 pm)**

If the student is going to be absent, please call the Church Office, Pastor Zahrte, or Shawn Hecksel with the reason why the student will not be attending.

◆ **Attendance at Sunday Worship**

◆ **Attendance at Sunday morning Junior Youth Bible Study (9:30am)**

◆ **Attendance at Wednesday evening Lenten Services (with parents)**

◆ **Attendance at monthly BASIC TRAINING events**

Two retreats, two “team building” events

These monthly events are an integral and necessary part of the BASIC TRAINING program. If the student cannot attend, service hours (equal to the hours of the event) can be completed as a substitution. Some service hour ideas = mailings, Sunday morning nursery. (NOTE: Students are not allowed to help in the nursery and then skip worship—or to help in the nursery at the 9:30 a.m. time slot when they should be attending Youth Bible Class at 9:30 a.m.)

◆ **Attendance at 2 of 4 service events that will be planned**

Throughout the year, OSL carries out various ministries needing volunteer help. The student is asked to sign up for and help with two. For both of these service events, the student must complete the **Service Event Evaluation Form** (see attached sheets) for it to be approved. Servant events done in conjunction with their school will not be counted as a service event.

◆ **Home Huddle Time**

Students and Parents are expected to be active in devotion **DAILY** at home. Along with the student workbooks, there is also a Home Huddle Journal after each lesson. You will find a weekly schedule attached with page numbers to help guide you along through the weeks. Please use this journal and the weekly devotions as it helps complete the whole learning approach to this confirmation program.

◆ **Memory Work**

All memory is due as soon as it is finished. Please turn in all memory work to Pastor Z when it is completed.

◆ **Completion of 12 sermon note sheets**

These must be completed and turned in to pastor before the end of the year.

They must complete all required sermon notes before confirmation. (an example can be found attached to the back of this packet, for more you can download them of the web.)

Additional Requirements for 8th GRADE Students

- ◆ Attendance at Communion Instruction Class (with parents)
- ◆ Statement of Faith (written)
- ◆ Confirmation Project
- ◆ Final Exam Review
- ◆ Written Examination (80% or better to pass)

POLICY ON FRIENDS

The following is a suggested format for dealing with friends who are invited or just come to confirmation class or small group time:

1. Friends are ***always*** welcome to come when the Pastor Zahrte or Shawn has been given advance notice of their attending.
2. Friends, who attend with notice and who wish to become a part of the program will need to come in and meet with Pastor Zahrte.
3. Anyone who becomes a part of the program commits for the duration, which means completion through the eighth grade year, unless extenuating circumstances dictate otherwise.
