

The Easter Difference: Transformed Focus

Acts 1:1-11

We focus on...

... an **unfinished task**. (v.1)

"In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach..."

... an **unchallenged message**. (v.3)

"... by many τεκμηρίοις decisive proofs."

- It can't be challenged by man.
- It can't be challenged by Satan.
- It can't be challenged by cults.

... an **unquestionable love**. (v.3)

"He presented himself alive to them after his παθειν passion by many proofs."

... an **unmistakable plan**. (v.8)

"...and you will be my witnesses...to the end of the earth."

... an **unshakable testimony**. (v.10)

"And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes..."

... an **unstoppable force**. (v.11&8)

"Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven?"

"...you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you..."

...an **unfailing promise** (v.11)

"This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."
