Call Meeting for OSS Director

The Our Savior School Director position was posted and the Hiring Committee began 12/31/22. They had several phone interviews and called in one candidate for a formal interview, who later withdrew their name.

The Board of Directors then approved to start the process to "Call" a synodically trained candidate 3/21/23. The Hiring Committee became the Call Committee.

The Call Committee met with Sean Martins 4/17/23 from the Minnesota South District Office and got access to the LCMS Database. A big list of qualified candidates was created and two candidates were willing to consider a "call." They spoke to Joni Davis on 5/4/23 and Stephanie Genske on 5/12/23.

SMP Program


