# **Confirmation Change**

In our efforts to make our 7th-8th grade confirmation program the best it can be, we are changing the day of the week we are meeting. Confirmation classes will take place <u>Sunday mornings</u> beginning **September 17 from 9:30-10:30am** and will <u>continue</u> on Sundays throughout the school year. We will <u>not</u> meet on Wednesday nights.

#### 6th-8th Grade Youth

One of the greatest responsibilities the church has is to raise up disciples, encouraging them in their faith, and teaching them everything that our Lord Jesus commanded (Matthew 28:20). This is important for all ages, but it is especially important that we make an effort to make disciples of the younger generations among us. Proverbs 22:6 says, "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it."

While parents will play the largest role in training their children in the way they should go, the church has a major role to play in this as well. This fall, as we seek to partner with parents in discipling their children, we will be upgrading our 6th-8th grade middle school ministry. We believe that this is a pivotal moment in the faith life of a young person and there is much more we can be doing to help these young people grow in their faith during this time.

Beginning on **Sunday, October 8**, 6th-8th Gr Woven Youth will begin meeting every **Sunday night** from **6:30-8:30pm** at the church. Woven is based on Psalm 139. *My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth (v. 15).* We will be doing Bible Study and prayer, but also playing games and engaging in other fun activities. The goal is to have these students grow in their faith in Jesus and to develop relationships with Christians their own age.

With this change in 6th-8th Gr, we will also be changing our confirmation schedule. We will no longer be meeting on Wednesday nights but will have confirmation on Sunday mornings from 9:30 -10:30am.

We look forward to partnering with parents to help their children to grow in their faith. We thank you in advance for your prayers and support and may God continue to bless you as you grow in your faith.
