### Sunday, January 28

#### **Holy Communion**

In the Bible, the Apostle Paul wrote: Let a person examine himself and so eat of the bread, and drink of the cup (1 Cor. 11:28). Before attending the Lord's Supper, ask yourself the following questions

- Do I believe that I am sinner, and am sorry for my sins? (Prov. 28:13; Rom. 3:23; I John 1:8-9)
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ by his death, offers me forgiveness for all my sins? (Rom. 5:8; Col. 2:13; Heb. 9:28; 1 John 1:7)
- Do I believe that I receive the body and blood of Christ in and with the bread and wine (not merely symbolically present)? (Mat. 26:26-28; 1 Cor. 10:16; 1 Cor. 11:24-25)
- Do I desire to turn from my sinful ways and live a God pleasing life by the power of the Holy Spirit? (Is. 1:16; John 8:11; Rom. 6:12)

If you are unable to answer yes to these questions, please talk to the pastor or an elder before communing, as participating without a proper understanding of Holy Communion can be spiritually harmful (1 Cor. 11:27-29).

If you can answer yes to these questions, then come with a repentant heart and join us in the reception of the Lord's Supper. Adults and children not yet instructed about Holy Communion are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.

#### From Rev. Matthew & Kali Wood

OIM Workers in Asia Visit Medan—Each January the LCMS OIM Asia Region workers and families meet together for an in person retreat. It's an important time for us to study God's word together, worship together, bounce ideas off each other, share our struggles, and encourage one another. This year the team came to Medan, Indonesia. Kali and I were overjoyed to be able to host the event in our home city.

In considering where we will meet each year it is important to our team that there be a church body with whom we work closely. This way the whole team can meet, encourage, and be encouraged by a local partner. So when we invited the GKLI to join us we knew that it was important to introduce not just the leadership, but also some of the GKLI traditions. We worshiped together according to the GKLI order of worship, which was translated into English. The GKLI followed along in Indonesian and Batak and the OIM families followed along in English. It was a blessing to be able to host the GKLI leadership and show them hospitality through doing our best to incorporate their language and their traditions into our worship time together.
