Holy Communion

In the Bible, the Apostle Paul wrote: Let a person examine himself and so eat of the bread, and drink of the cup (1 Cor. 11:28). Before attending the Lord's Supper, ask yourself the following questions

- Do I believe that I am sinner, and am sorry for my sins? (Prov. 28:13; Rom. 3:23; I John 1:8-9)
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ by his death, offers me forgiveness for all my sins? (Rom. 5:8; Col. 2:13; Heb. 9:28; 1 John 1:7)
- Do I believe that I receive the body and blood of Christ in and with the bread and wine (not merely symbolically present)? (Mat. 26:26-28; 1 Cor. 10:16; 1 Cor. 11:24-25)
- Do I desire to turn from my sinful ways and live a God pleasing life by the power of the Holy Spirit? (Is. 1:16; John 8:11; Rom. 6:12)

If you are unable to answer yes to these questions, please talk to the pastor or an elder before communing, as participating without a proper understanding of Holy Communion can be spiritually harmful (1 Cor. 11:27-29).

If you can answer yes to these questions, then come with a repentant heart and join us in the reception of the Lord's Supper. Adults and children not yet instructed about Holy Communion are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.

Building Expansion Committee Update

After a fascinating Tuesday evening of interviewing our three highly qualified architectural candidates, the Building Expansion Committee (BEC) went home to pray and contemplate over our decision. We agreed to meet Thursday night to discuss our choices.

The BEC is happy to announce our unanimous decision to recommend Station 19 as our choice as the architect of our building expansion project

One of the things that stood out in favor of Station 19 was their clear commitment as a faith biased organization. A company that demonstrates the act of growing God's ministries through the building of churches. That is all they do.

Station 19 is also very active in the west metro area. They have designed a number of projects in Minnetonka, Excelsior and Plymouth. Thus making them familiar with our community needs.

One of the more notable qualities of Station 19 was their use of the Vision Casting Concept. This is where they assist us to build congregational consensus on a single vision building project. All in an effort to provide hospitality in the form of accessibility for members, a welcoming environment for guests, and a transitional atmosphere for our worship services.
